I understand the following:

- 1. Prior to planting anything in the ground, you need written approval from the Landscape Committee. Whatever you plant, you must maintain.
- 2. A total of two (2) plants, herbs, veggies in pots and/or lawn ornaments per condo are allowed for the front of condo plus two (2) of any of these for the backside of condo with pots not to exceed 24" in height. If your neighbor doesn't want to use his/her allocation, you may use theirs. Neighbors are defined by the 4 units around a stairwell.
- 3. Broken or half buried pots are not allowed. Nor is fishing line that is used to tie back plants. No double stacking of pots is allowed because all create a potential safety hazard.
- 4. Keep plants 6-12" away from walkway so as not to create a safety hazard.
- 5. No raised flower beds or boxes of any kind are allowed. Solar lights are okay with prior approval from the Landscape Committee.
- 6. All plants in pots must be maintained and removed during hurricane season. Please make arrangements with your Home Watch or neighbor in your absence.
- 7. Only hummingbird feeders are allowed.
- 8. Trees and shrubs cannot be planted.
- 9. Mulch color is dark brown if you choose to add your own.
